The school has taken immense strides to reach this state of repute and recognition that it commands in the city today. The journey has been enriching and the student strength has increased from a mere 150 to 943 in these years.

The school is proudly comprehensive, co-educational and multi-cultural in nature, with a fine tradition of academic achievements and community engagement. The school offers classes from Nursery to Grade 10 and will be opening up Grade 11 in the the next academic year with the Science and Commerce streams.

Manipal School is a progressive school and a high achieving school. The world of learning has undergone radical changes and in this challenging environment of digital explosion and knowledge economy we can say with pride that we have kept pace with newer teaching methodologies which cater to the continually changing needs of the learner.

ON THE ACADEMIC FRONT:

At Manipal School we follow the inter disciplinary teaching methods so that students are able to integrate the co-curricular disciplines and acquire a wider perspective. So learning becomes more meaningful and is not restricted to the classrooms. Our teaching methodologies are outcome-centric. This helps identify the progress students make after a specific learning activity, determining the gap between their existing learning condition and their desired learning state, while providing better direction to the planning of all learning activities. We maintain a learner centric focal point with the core curriculum prescribed by the CBSE, supported by well researched materials, innovative lesson plans, engaging activities, cross curricular activities and digital content. The supplementary curriculum complements the core curriculum with innovative co scholastic programmes such as the Science Expreiential learning kit, Innovation lab activities, Board Prep and and Focussed remedials. The value added curricula and activities to develop the 21st century skills with the English Enrichment Programme, Green School Programme, Newspaper in Education and Career Guidance, Community service / connect and Revival of a lost art form.

I extend my hearty congratulations to the eighth batch of Grade 10 students for their brilliant performance in the board exams. Twenty- one out of ninety one students have scored above 90% in all the subjects.

Ishitha M Jain was the school topper with 97.8%. followed by Avani Muniyangala and Neva Palazhi who scored 96.4%.

Our target threshold in the junior classes are constantly challenged by our students and they have performed extremely well in the year end exams.

The English Language Enrichment Programme in Grades 1 to 8 has shown a significant improvement in students' English language skills.

Innovation is the need of the hour, and to innovate one needs to develop an innovative mindset. The projects have helped children to develop a Maker mindset, growth mindset and team mindset which is collectively called the innovation mindset. This programme has got the children thinking differently.

The Innovation / Robotics Lab activities, Hands On Science Activities, Focussed Remedials, have improved student performance in the core subjects.

It is imperative that I mention here that we have team of over 52 extremely dedicated teachers who constantly upgrade themselves with the latest methods in teaching leaving no room for complacency.

During the Pandemic the teachers trained themselves to handle the online classes. They attended a number of workshops, training sessions, taken part in competitive exams, quizzes and have presented case studies in various programs organized by the Professional Development team of the CBSE.

Co-Curricular activities:

At Manipal School we carry out a broad spectrum of co-curricular activities. Various inter and intra school competitions are held to hone the aptitude and skills of the students.

Manipalites have won awards in quizzes, dance, flower arrangement, rangoli, basketball, Olympiads, football, chess, swimming and karate. My heartiest congratulations to all these achievers.

The library programme called the 15 Books Campaign encourages students to read a minimum 15 books in a year. The students also take part in book fairs, reading campaigns, do books reviews and do book commercials. This programme is very popular and has given rise to many budding writers.

Socio Emotional learning (SEL) is an integral part of the school programme. The community service club has been very active with awareness drives, visits to the old age homes, orphanages and mobility centre for the visually challenged and joy of giving drives. In addition to having a competent school counsellor. Manipal School also organizes interactive career awareness sessions for the students of Grade 6 to 8 and Career guidance for Grade 9 and 10 with leading personalities from various fields like hotel management, medicine, engineering, law, accountancy and the merchant navy.

The School organizes regular excursions both within India and abroad to help the children experience real life situations. The immersion trips to the US and Japan have provided the students with a flavor of internationalism.

The Manipal Excellence Awards for student excellence - MEA aims at recognizing children with outstanding performance in academics and co-curricular activities. This platform has been established with the objective of encouraging children to feel proud and be rewarded for their academic and co-curricular achievements.

The awards ceremony was held during the first term of the academic year and more than 350 students have won awards such as Super Achiever, Star Achiever, Astounding Artist and Sporty Soul.

The school cultural fest Tirangaa 2021 was held online and students from all grades participated in the event.

Manipal Sparkle 2021- The annual day of the school was held in the month December 2021 and all the students performed in this programme but we were not able to invite parents due to covid restrictions.

Manipal's Mind Spark', the Annual School Exhibition for the students of Nursery to Grade 10 is an event of great importance as it offers students an opportunity to put into practice what they have learnt in their classes. This invariably means additional research, creative thinking, learning from those with experience and most importantly the realization that there are certain things, which cannot be learned from books alone but need real life experiences. It will also offer an opportunity for our students to acquire presentation and communication skills. Moreover, it could awaken an interest in our students when considering their future career.

AUDIT AND AWARDS:

Health Safety and Child Protection (HSCP) is an integral part of the work done at School. And encompasses all stakeholders areas such as CCTV, Coverage of common areas School transport, fire safety, electrical safety, chemical safety, visitor management, classrooms, infirmary, washrooms, physical safety and child protection across all locations in the School.

Transport

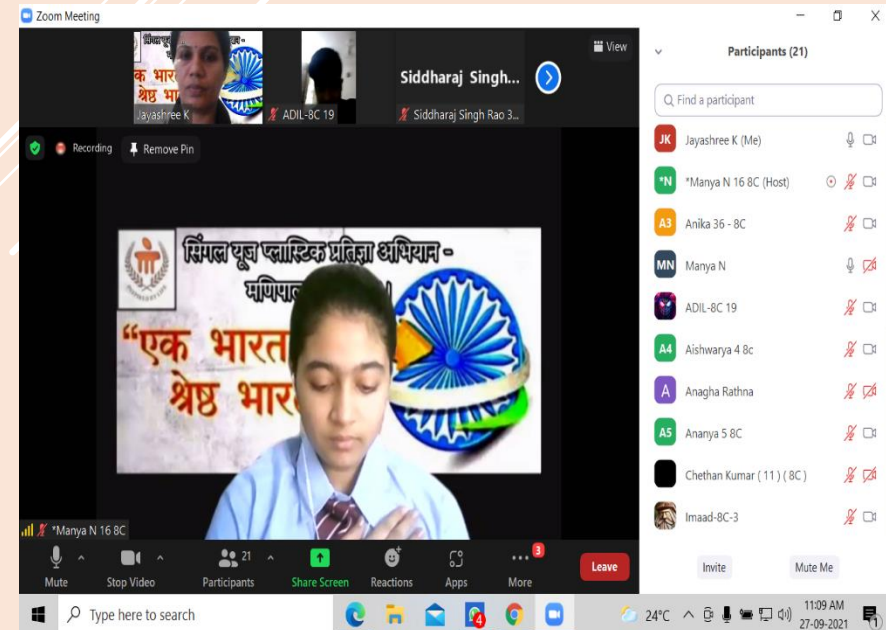
- There has been drastic changes in transport in India since independence.
- Indian roadways is the second-largest in the world with a length of 68,53,024 kilometres. India's road network carries over 71 percent of its freight and about 85 percent of passenger traffic.
- The Indian railways is the fourth-largest railway network in the world, with a route length of 67956 km. As of 31 March 2020, 45,881 km or 71% of all the broad-gauge routes are electrified.
- The railway is also trying solar powered stations and trains in order to be carbon-neutral.
- India's civil aviation network is third largest in the world. Currently, India has 132 roads. Air India is India's national flag carrier.
- India has a coastline of 7,517 km, and thus ports are the main centers of trade. An extensive network of inland waterways is also present.
- The Golden Quadrilateral (GQ) is a national highway network connecting most of the major industrial, agricultural and cultural centers of India. It forms a quadrilateral connecting the four major metro cities of India - viz. Delhi (north), Kolkata (east)
