How the program works:

- Provides each student with learning material, including a textbook and app based access to audio
- Students have one period of music per week which is timetabled. Activity based learning and students also have access to simple instruments and specially created video content.

- Trained music faculty on both syllabus and methodology.
- Monthly lesson plans which are checked and verified by the SaPa Coordinator.
