



ANNUAL MEDICAL CHECK-UP - The annual medical check-up was conducted on November 7 and 8, 2017. Doctors from KMC Hospital checked on the students' weight, teeth and eyes, and gave medical advice wherever required.

CAREER GUIDANCE - A career guidance session was organized for the students of Grade 10 on the November 13th, 2017 at MCODS. The program had two parts, first was for the parents which was addressed by Dr. Rameela Shekar, a leading counsellor who spoke on the role of parents in children's career path. The second part was addressed by Dr. Rama Prasad who briefed the students about the different career options. The students gained knowledge on careers and were able to choose the right path to achieve their goal in life.

SWACCH MANAS - Ramakrishna Mission, Mangalore has launched the 'Swachh Manas' campaign to educate the students about the need to keep our city and country clean. They have enrolled students as the ambassadors for cleanliness. 100 schools from Mangalore are taking part in this campaign, we have enrolled 104 students from our school, from Grade 8 & 9. This is a five month program that has begun in November and will end in March.

GROW READING PROGRAMME - The students from Grade 1 to 4 are doing the GROW program. ORAL HYGIENE - Dr. Yasir from SODC society for oral and dental care organization gave a talk on oral hygiene for students and staff on November 23rd, 2017. He stressed on basic step of maintaining oral hygiene like proper brushing method, Flossing, proper diet and regular dental checkups.

Olympiad exam is conducted in Manipal School. Students can appear for G.K. English, Science, Math and Cyber, but only three subjects-English, Science and Math will be qualified for the 2nd level. Last year in 2016 overall 25 students were qualified for the 2nd level, but this year 27 students qualified only in English for the 2nd level. This year hopefully we will acquire more number of students in the 2nd level. Teachers have started Olympiad coaching from grade 1-4 every Saturdays. Students have showed their excitement and enthusiasm to participate, parents are encouraging their children to participate and teachers are supporting and guiding them. 2nd level exam will be held in Manipal School in the 2nd week of February 2018. As a token of appreciation qualified students will be awarded with certificates, medals and gift vouchers in the assembly.



SCOUT/GUIDE MEET CAMP - On 11th and 12th November a Scouts and Guides camp was organised by Amrita Vidyalaya, Mangalore. 27 students participated in the camp, accompanied by Mrs. Jayalaxmi and Mrs. Deepti. The opening ceremony was done by hoisting the Scouts and Guides flag, followed by prayer song and flag song. On 11th November there was a rally for the students, followed by a bonfire. The students danced, sang and performed magical show. Next day, 12th November, the day began with 'All faith prayer'. Competitions like mask-making, collage, drawing, kite-making and adventure games were conducted by the teachers of Bharat Scouts and Guides. The students were taken to Sultan Bathery to clean the place near the fort and beach as a part of cleanliness program. The students learnt values like punctuality, cleanliness, friendship and self-reliance.
