PROGRAMMES AND EVENTS AT SCHOOL

CHILDREN'S DAY - Children's day was celebrated on November 14th, in the school with lot of fun and gaiety. The teachers banded together and sang many songs and performed a humorous skit. The teachers' performances were filled with zest and enthusiasm. Cakes were distributed to all students. Games and different fun activities were conducted by the class teachers. IKFFI an international kids film festival was organized in school. Children were exposed to a curated list global cinema. Each of the films was a treat to watch and carried message for the students.





ENFOLD – PERSONAL SAFETY PROGRAM - The Enfold programme was conducted for Grades 5-10. Well experienced resource persons from had week long discussions with the students. The sessions revolved around topics like puberty and the changes that take place during that phase of life, handling relationships and friendships and different kinds of abuse. The students were given an opportunity to clarify their doubts regarding these topics. They were made aware of all kinds of problems they would face if they did not follow the right path and were advised on how they could handle such situations.

HALLOWEEN PARTY - The students of Grade 10 had organized a Halloween Party. On this day, students and teachers dressed in Halloween costumes. There was music and dance with a lot of food. Both students and teachers had a fun evening together.

KANNADA AND HINDI SAPTHAH - The Kannada Sapthah was conducted in the 1st week of November. Various competitions like singing, anthakshari and collage making were organized. The children participated in the competitions and exhibited their talents. Hindi Sapthah had competitions like 'Masti Bhare Gane' and 'Pick and talk' The students participated with enthusiasm and zest. The winners were appreciated and were given an opportunity to perform in the morning assembly.

CLASS PICNIC - School picnics provide the children a break from the regular humdrum of academics. Students from pre-primary to Grade 10 went on picnics to different places like the Thousand Pillars Basadi in Moodabidre, Pillikula Nisargadhama, Treepark in Taneerbhavi, St. Aloysius Chapel and Museum, etc. The students of Grade 10 went to Kadamakoli resort in Coorg for a three day outbound experience with training in life skills.

Teacher talk by Mrs. Shilpa Moger also enlightened the students about the causes and precautions.
